Instruction Card: Beginning February 1st, read a verse for each day leading up to Valentine's Day. Read the verse together as a family and talk about what that verse means. Look for ways to live out that verse or for ways that you see God's love displayed during the day (you can even report back at the end of the day). Consider hanging them on a Valentine's tree, near the family table or somewhere special. At the end of 14 days, you will have a beautiful reminder of God's love on display!
